

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENGLISH FOXHOUNDS

1. Classes are open to hounds from any Pack recognised by B.H.S.A entered in or, in the case of unentered hounds, eligible for entry in the Foxhound Kennel Stud Book.
2. a). All hounds must have been bred by the exhibitor or his predecessor except for Class 7. Draft Hounds may NOT otherwise be shown.
b). Note: Breeder is owner of bitch at time of service.
c). Hounds must be shown in the name of the pack under which they were registered in the Foxhound Kennel Stud Book (except for Class 7).
3. Breeding of hounds must be given as required on entry forms, with correct year of entry in Studbook. Please do not use ditto marks, brackets or underlines.
4. See Schedule for Conditions of Entry for each Class and number of hounds that may be entered and shown. Substitution entries are NOT permitted, except for unentered hounds and these must be received at the Secretary's Office at least 24 hours before the date of the Show.
5. NOMINATIONS FOR EACH CLASS must be declared at the Secretary's Office for Doghounds by 9.00 a.m. and Bitches by 1.00 p.m.
6. Masters are reminded of their responsibility when entering hounds in relation to the cough and other diseases. It is strongly recommended that all hounds to be shown have been vaccinated for the cough. We are advised that where the cough is concerned a period of four weeks from the last case should be allowed before any hounds from that Kennel are taken to a Hound Show.
7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry.
8. No hound which has won a Cup or First Prize at previous Shows shall be shown for that Cup or Prize.
9. No responsibility will be accepted for injury to, or death of, a hound, or for any injury or damage caused by a hound whilst in the showground.
10. Hunt Uniform must be worn in the Rings by those showing hounds.
11. Entry fee £35 per Pack and at least one Master per Pack must be a Vice President (Subscription £30).
12. It is requested that all hounds arrive at the showground before 9.00 a.m.
13. Judging will commence at 10.00 a.m.
14. ALL ENTRIES except Classes 8 and 16 to be received by the Secretary before SATURDAY 23rd MAY 2026.
15. Entered and unentered hounds are eligible for the Championships (Classes 8 and 16). Previous Peterborough Champions are NOT eligible for the Championships.

16. Restricted Classes 1,4,5,9,12 and 13. To Confirm the recognised shows are Ardingly, Harrogate, Honiton and Peterborough main ring, (not including The Peterborough Old English ring) and The Wales & Border Counties Hound Show.
17. Entries for Old English prizes must be $\frac{3}{4}$ Old English and have no more than one "modern" grandparent or two "modern" great grandparents in an otherwise "Old English" pedigree. If it is not obvious whether the grandparent or great grandparent is Modern or Old English then you should check back as far as necessary. Hounds that are $\frac{5}{8}$ or $\frac{11}{16}$ Old English for example will not be accepted.
