

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

WELSH FOXHOUNDS

1. Classes are open to hounds from any recognised Pack, entered in, or eligible for entry in, Section One of the Welsh Hound Association Stud Book.
2. All hounds must have been bred by the exhibitor or his predecessor. Draft hounds must not be shown.
3. Breeding of hounds must be given as required on entry forms, with correct year of entry in Stud Book. Please do not use ditto marks, brackets or underlines.
4. Not more than three entries from any pack to be shown in a Class, but the number of entries are not limited.
5. Substitution entries are not permitted for any Classes.
6. Masters are reminded of their responsibility when entering hounds in relation to the cough and other diseases. We are advised that where the cough is concerned a period of four weeks from the last case should be allowed before any hounds from that Kennel are taken to a Hound Show.
7. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry/entries.
8. Judges may require hounds to be shown off lead.
9. No responsibility will be accepted for injury to, or death of a hound, or for any injury or damage caused by a hound whilst in the Showground.
10. Hunt livery or white coats and hard hats must be worn in the ring.
11. Entry Fee £35 per Pack and at least 1 Master per Pack must be a Vice-President.

12. It is requested that all hounds arrive at the Showground before 9.00 a.m.
